Why a Chromebook?

- **Chrome offers a simpler interface**
- **Chrome Browser is most popular Internet browser**
- **Chrome is more secure than Windows – virus free**
- **Chrome Laptops are generally lighter than Windows**
- **Chromebooks are inexpensive**
- **Over 50% of new school purchases are Chromebooks**

If your usage is Web Browsing and Web E-Mail, Chrome is for you.

- Access Internet - Edge
- Outlook, Hotmail, Gmail
- Create and Print items
- Share files with OneDrive
- Apps from Windows Store
- Windows Games
- Photoshop
- Work Offline



Why a Chromebook - NOT?

- You don't Trust the Cloud
- You use Video and Photo Editing Extensively
- You like applying updates and Anti-virus definitions
- All your files are on DVD's and you play DVD's on PC
- You use Skype video – but Skype online may suffice
- Everything you do uses Microsoft Office

If you run many Windows programs, you probably can't find the equivalent for Chromebook.
