How to Get the Windows 10 Fall Creators Update

Windows 10 will notify you when the Fall Creators Update is available for your device. The updated is Windows 10, version 1709. To see which version of Windows 10 your device is currently running, select the **Start** button, then select **Settings** > **System** > **About**.

If you want to install the update now, go to the [Microsoft software download website](#) and select **Update now**.

Before doing this, you'll need to [make sure your device is up to date](#). Select the **Start** button, then select **Settings** > **Update & security** > **Windows Update**. Select **Check for updates**. If updates are available, install them.
